When you file a suit for wrongful dismissal, the court compensates you for the amount you would have received from your previous benefits and salary. Nonetheless, whichever notice or pay that you received is subtracted from the awarded amount.

It is your task to find work after your position is terminated. The court considers your efforts, but will also subtract whichever income earned throughout the reasonable notice period from the awarded amount.

For example: If you only got eight weeks notice prior to termination when you were entitled to 8 months notice, the court will calculate the amount you could have earned at a different job and award damages accordingly. The courts take into account bonuses, pension, insurance, medical plans, moving expenses, stock options, and vacation pay when determining how much damages they should award.

In extreme situations, the court might also compensate an employee for undergoing abuse, mental distress or defamation after termination.
